ORDER

As per National Medical Council PG regulations clause 14(1) sub clause (2), the maximum number of students to be examined in clinical/practical and oral on any day shall not exceed eight for MD/MS Degree/Diploma.

- 2. As per KUHS Syllabus, the maximum number of Students to be examined in clinical/practical and oral on any day shall not exceed Six for MD/MS Degree.
- 3. The Examination Committee decided that the number of candidates per day may be increased to seven as per the NMC guidelines based upon the discretion of the Controller of Examinations.
- 4. Considering the requests received from various colleges/Chairman Practical Examinations/Conveners, the Controller of Examinations has granted permission to conduct the Practical Examination (Medical PG Degree R/S Examinations, July 2023) with 7 candidates per day subject to the ratification of the Board of Examinations.
- 5. The 37th meeting of BoE held on 14/12/2023, ratified the decision taken by the Controller of Examinations to increase the number of candidates per day for Medical PG Practical Examination from Six to Seven for Medical PG Degree/Diploma(Regular/supplementary) Examination July 2023. *The BoE* decided to continue the number of candidates per day as seven for Medical PG Degree Practical **Examination from the forthcoming PG Practical Examinations**, vide paper read as (1) above.
- 6. The 77th meeting of the Governing Council held on 21/12/2023 has considered the aforementioned recommendations of BoE and resolved to approve the same, vide paper read as (2) above.
