## ABSTRACT

## **ORDER**

As per the paper read (1) above, the maximum number of students to be evaluated in University 'practical/viva voce' to be '25 Nos' in a day (for all streams), unless otherwise stipulated in the respective Statutory Council/University Course Regulations.

- 2. The Pharmacy Council of India and the University have not fixed the number of students to be included in the practical examinations per day for B.Pharm Semester Scheme. With respect to the B.Pharm Semester scheme, Regular and Supplementary examinations of each semester are conducted at an interval of six months. Practical examination of each subject is conducted for 3 consecutive days (9 AM to 1 PM daily) in a college with the sanctioned intake of 60 students. It requires two weeks of time to complete the entire practical examinations of each semester and this affects other day-today academic related activities.
- 3.. Considering the matter, Dean Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences proposed to conduct B Pharm semester practical examinations in two batches (with maximum of 25 students per batch) per day (one batch in the morning & the other in the afternoon) to reduce the duration of examination process from three days to two days, without creating additional burden for students which would minimize disruptions of regular academics, allowing for more continuous and focused teaching throughout the Semester.
- 4. The 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of BoE held on 14/12/2023 vide paper read as (2) above has approved the proposal to conduct practical examinations of two batches of B.Pharm Semester Scheme in one day (one batch in the morning & the other in the afternoon) as proposed by the Dean Faculty of Pharmaceutical sciences by relaxing the practical exam conducting norms (concerning number of students to be attended for the practical examinations per day) prescribed in the University Order No. 114/2017/Exam General dated 25.09.2017.

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction to implement the above decision of the Governing Council with respect to the relaxation of the conditions (related to the number of students to attend the practical examinations per day) mentioned in the University Order vide read as (1) above, related to the practical examinations in B Pharm Semester system.
