## **ORDER**

As per the University order read (1) above, the University Charges fee for Cancellation of Student Registration from the students who discontinue a course. Currently, the University does not ask the reason from the College while they are applying for the cancellation of a student's registration and collects the fee for every students including that of expired students. Several requests have been received to exempt fee for cancellation of Student Registration of expired students. As per the Kerala University of Health Sciences Act 2010, Section 23(10), power to fix and regulate the fees payable by the students in colleges affiliated to the University is vested upon the Governing Council and the matter was placed before the Governing Council for consideration.

Vide paper read (2) above, the Governing Council decided to grant exemption from levying fee for cancellation of Student Registration before or after approving the registration in the case of expired students.

Accordingly, orders are issued exempting collection of fee for the cancellation of Student Registration before or after approving the registration, in the case of expired students.
