Training Program on Effective Implementation of New BAMS Curriculum under KUHS: Planning and implementation

The new curriculum revision envisioned by NCISM brings out paradigm shift in the outlook of Ayurveda undergraduate education by incorporating outcome based plan and novel pedagogic approaches. Most of the teaching learning practices are new to Ayurvedic faculties, since they are not regularly updated with innovations in T-L practices. Also, improvisations of T-L practices suiting to the content of Ayurveda is much necessitated. The new curriculum needs series of active discussions among teachers and to evolve consensus in practical implementation of the same. Teachers have already started discussions under different platforms and the concerns raised from such discussions are worthy addressing by KUHS. In this background, KUHS is planning to conduct Training Program and Workshop on Effective Implementation of New BAMS Curriculum under KUHS.

Aims of the program

1. To train teachers of I Professional BAMS on the principles and practices of outcome based education as envisaged in the new curriculum
2. To train the participants on principles of assessment in the background of new curriculum
3. To familiarize the participants with different interactive teaching learning practices
4. To design subject specific T-L practices based on interactive learning
5. To prepare guidelines for effective documentation of non-lecture practices in the background of new curriculum

Two phases

Phase-1: Online sessions on Teaching Methodology in the background of new curriculum which is mandatory for 1st BAMS Teachers of colleges affiliated to KUHS. Interested faculties of other subjects can also attend.

Phase-II: Workshop on effective implementation of new curriculum in 1st Professional BAMS which should be attended by one Senior teacher from each Institution in each subject in 1st BAMS, (i.e 17 Colleges * 4 Subjects = 68 Faculty), which will be conducted at KUHS Head Quarters, Thrissur.

Eligibility Criteria of participants: Faculty members of Ayurveda colleges under KUHS who possesses an FEP number, dealing with subjects of 1st Professional BAMS.
