CERTIFICATE PROGRAM ON BIOETHICS

Knowledge on ethical, social, legal and moral issues involved in medicine and health care is essential to prepare health care professionals to recognize difficult situations and to deal with them in a rational and principled manner. It is important in health care delivery, research and in interactions of health care professionals with colleagues and society. KUHS in its endeavour to accelerate academics and research in the field of health science, is offering an online certificate program on Bioethics. In this program, resource persons will be covering the basic aspects of Bioethics that a health care provider needs to know.

Objectives of the program: To empower the post-graduate students and faculty of affiliated colleges of KUHS with adequate knowledge in the ethical aspects of research and practice in their fields.

Beneficiaries: Post-graduate students and faculty of all colleges affiliated to KUHS.

Venue: Online Learning Management System of the University (Moodle platform). The link to access the program will be provided to the registered participants through e-mail. Doubts and questions from participants can be cleared through online discussion group associated with the programme.

Eligibility for admission: Post graduate students with KUHS registration number and teachers with KUHS FEP number.

Duration of the program: 4 to 6 weeks

Date of commencement of the program – May 2025 (Date will be announced later)

The participants can register till June 15th 2025. (Those who have registered after commencement of classes will also be able to view all the uploaded classes/learning materials).





Topics -

Module 1 – Introduction to Bioethic – historical development of bioethics, Key ethical principles in biomedical research

Module 2 – Rules and regulations – ICMR guidelines and their significance in Indian medical research, NDCT rules and their implications for clinical trials in India

Module 3 – Good clinical practices (GCP)

Module – 4 Good laboratory practices (GLP)

Module 5 – Professional Ethics and responsibility, Medical professionalism, Shared confidentiality, Data sharing, Patient – Doctor relation, Pharma – Doctor relation

Course fee: Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One thousand only).

Assessment

MCQ based test based on all the portions covered in the sessions will be conducted after completion of the course.

Eligibility for certification: Completion of course with at least 50 % marks for assessment test.
