Internal Assessment – 100 marks  80 marks – marks scored in exams  20 marks – Professionalism, day to day activities, research, extra curriculum  Pass criteria  IA – 50% combined in theory and practicals (not less than 40% in each) for eligibility for appearing for University examination  Learners must secure at least 50% marks of the total marks (combined in theory and practical / clinical; not less than 40% marks in theory and practical separately) assigned for internal assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible for appearing at the final University examination of that subject
