

## CBME- SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

<p>University Examination</p>	<p>Long Essays 2x15 Marks =30 marks (one should be case based)</p> <p>Short Essays 5x8 Marks = 40 marks</p> <p>Brief Answer/diagrams 5x4 Marks= 20 marks</p> <p>Precise Answers 10x1 Marks = 10 marks</p> <p><b>Pass criteria</b></p> <p>University Exam – 50% in theory + practicals , separately (practicals = practicals +viva)</p> <p>In subjects that have two papers, the learner must secure at least 40% marks in each of the papers with minimum 50% of marks in aggregate (both papers together) to pass.</p>
<p>Internal Examinations</p> <p>(IA – Not less than 3 examination in a year.</p> <p>Prior to University examination additional tests may be conducted as and when required. )</p>	<p>Internal Assessment – 100 marks</p> <p>80 marks – marks scored in exams</p> <p>20 marks – Professionalism, day to day activities , research, extra curriculum</p> <p><b>Pass criteria</b></p> <p>IA – 50% combined in theory and practicals (not less than 40% in each) for eligibility for appearing for University examination</p> <p><b>Learners must secure at least 50% marks of the total marks (combined in theory and practical / clinical; not less than 40 % marks in theory and practical separately) assigned for internal assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible for appearing at the final University examination of that subject</b></p>
