### Clause 3.1 Eligibility for examination

#### Condonation of shortage of attendance

i) There is no provision for condonation of shortage of attendance for BSc Nursing programme

ii) A minimum of 80% attendance for both theory & practical separately

are required for appearing for University examinations as per statutory council regulations.

### Clause 3.4 Declaration of class (Regular/Supplementary)

Final marks (Internal/ college examinations and university examinations together as in the mark list) shall be converted to grade, based on UGC 10 point grading system modified with pass grade as follows.
