CORRIGENDUM

The Chairman, BoS Physiotherapy has informed that there are some changes in the regulations of BPT course.

i. In Section 2 clause 10 of the BPT it is mentioned that a candidate is not permitted to attend second year examination unless he /she clears first year subjects. He/She is not permitted to appear in the final year examination unless he /she clear all I II and III year subjects is modified as A candidate is not permitted to appear in the final year examination unless he /she clears all the papers of I, II and III year BPT course.
