CORRIGENDUM

Vide UO read (1) the present regulations of BPharm(Ayurveda) was modified as follows:

Eligibility for appearing for University Examination: - There should be 80% attendance in all subjects (theory and practical separately) and a candidate must obtain 35% of marks in internal assessment in all subjects to be eligible to write the university examination. The class average of internal assessment marks should not exceed 75%.

Criteria for Pass: - A candidate should secure 50% aggregate marks in each subject with practical (theory + IA & Practical + Viva + IA) and in each subject without practical (theory + Viva + IA) and 45% in University theory and University practical (Practical + viva + IA) separately. Moreover, 50% aggregate marks in theory (theory + IA) and practical (practical + viva voce + IA) should be obtained.

Grace Marks: - Maximum 5 marks can be given to a subject or shall be distributed among different subjects for a whole pass or a subject pass (theory / Practical) as per the discretion of the pass board. No grace marks will be given for internal assessment.

Promotion: - The candidates who are eligible to appear for University Examination are eligible for promotion.

MODIFICATION

This regulation is applicable for 2010 Admission (Third Year onwards), 2011 Admission (Second year onwards) and from 2012 admissions onwards.

Eligibility for appearing for University Examination: - There should be 80% attendance in all subjects (theory and practical separately) and a candidate must obtain 35% of marks in internal assessment in all subjects to be eligible to write the university examination. The class average of internal assessment marks should not exceed 75%.

Criteria for Pass: - A candidate should secure 50% aggregate marks in each subject with practical (theory + Practical + Viva) and in each subject without practical (theory + Viva) and 45% in University theory and University practical (Practical + viva) separately. Moreover, 50% aggregate marks in theory (theory) and practical (practical + viva voce) should be obtained.

Grace Marks: - Maximum 5 marks can be given to a subject or shall be distributed among different subjects for a whole pass or a subject pass (theory / Practical) as per the discretion of the pass board. No grace marks will be given for internal assessment.

Promotion: - The candidates who are eligible to appear for University Examination are eligible for promotion.

Internal Assessment is considered only for eligibility criteria to write exam.
