Sub: - KUHS – Discharge of students from BDS course – Reg.

Ref: - 1. Decision of the Executive Committee of Dental Council of India dated 8/7/2014.

- 3. Recommendations of Chairman, Board of Studies, U.G. Dental Science and Dean, Faculty of Dental Science dated 17/9/2014.

Based on the representation received from 2010 batch enrolled in dental colleges affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences, the Executive Committee of the Dental Council of India has decided to substitute the existing regulation that "Any students who does not clear the 1st year BDS examination in all subjects within 3 years from the date of admission shall be discharged from the course" as

"Any student who does not clear the BDS course in all subjects within a period of 9 years including one year compulsory rotating internship from the date of admission shall be discharged from the course".

The decision of the Executive Committee of the Dental council of India is sent to the Central Government for seeking its prior approval u/s 20 of the Dentists Act for further amending the Revised BDS course Regulations, 2007 to the extent indicated hereinabove and a draft of the amendment is sent to the Central Government for consideration and final approval.

The decision of the Executive Committee was informed to the Kerala University of Health Sciences vide paper read 2) above.

In order to impart this benefit to the aggrieved First year BDS students of 2010 batch who were discharged from the course as they had not cleared the 1st year BDS examination in all subjects within 3 years from the date of admission, the Chairman, Board of studies U.G. Dental Science and Dean, Faculty of Dental Science had recommended to implement this modified regulation from 2010-11 admission onwards and to permit the students who were discharged from BDS course on the basis of the existing regulation by readmitting provisionally to the course, provided the student should complete the course within a period of 9 years including one year internship i.e. by 2019, subject to final approval of the Central Government. The students shall not be levied any fee for readmission.

Implementation of the regulation based on the recommendation of Dean, Faculty of Dental Science and Chairman, Board of Studies U.G. Dental Science is subject to ratification of the Academic Council and Governing Council.
