**Guidelines for dissertation evaluation**

- Each candidate shall submit 4 copies of Dissertation to the Principal and a soft copy of the same to the Controller of Examinations at the stipulated time prescribed by the University.
- The external and internal examiners shall download the evaluation criteria, from the University (KUHS) Website [kuhs.ac.in](http://kuhs.ac.in) prior to the actual conduct of the Dissertation viva voce.
- External and Internal examiners shall evaluate the Dissertation prior to the conduct of viva voce based on the given evaluation criteria.
- External and Internal examiners shall jointly conduct viva voce for each candidate based on the given criteria. Twenty minutes time shall be given for the presentation and another twenty minutes for viva voce for each candidates. Maximum number of candidates shall not be more than 6 per day.
