Minimum Required **Teaching Experience** 4 yrs as Senior Lecturer. Total 4 years teaching experience after PG. Publications\* (20 points)

#### Note:

- 1. All the faculty should be full time. Part time faculty cannot be accepted.
- 2. The Reader/Associate Professor in a dental college shall attend teachers training program once in three years.
- 3. The Senior Residents with post graduate qualification or Diplomate of National Board recognized by the council, in the specialty having teaching experience in dental colleges may be considered equivalent to Lecturer/Assistant Professor.
- 4. Teaching experience in a private dental institution for less than one year shall not be considered relevant for post –graduate faculty.

- 5. The maximum age limit upto which a person can be appointed or granted extension or reemployed in service against the post of dental teachers or Dean or Principal, as the case shall be, sixty five years.6. A minimum of 9 years of teaching experience is mandatory for a Reader to be a PG teacher/guide.

- 5. For the purposes of this table, the crucial date for consideration of the publications shall be the last date for submission of application i.e. 30<sup>th</sup> of June of every year either for starting of MDS Course or increase of admission capacity in MDS Course, as the case may be, to the Central Government u/s 10A of the Dentists Act, 1948, for each academic year, as prescribed in the Time Schedule annexed to the Dental Council of India Regulations 2006 as amended from time to time.
