NOTIFICATION

It is notified for the information of all concerned that the candidates appearing for the Medical Superspeciality (DM & M.Ch) Supplementary examination to be conducted tentatively in January 2021 should submit the **final thesis to University before 5.00 pm on 25.11.2020** with fee of Rs 3310/-. However, candidates can submit the **thesis with a fine of Rs.5515/-** (Total Rs.8825/-) upto 5.00 pm on 04.12.2020. The fee should be paid by online.

The 'abstract' of the thesis should be renamed as 'structured abstract' and it should be prepared in the format prescribed. The details of the thesis should be submitted online from 09.11.2020 to 20.11.2020 in the case of candidates submitting without fine, and from 25.11.2020 to 30.11.2020 in the case of candidates submitting with fine. Three copies of the thesis along with three soft copies should be submitted. The content of each CD has to be a single PDF file, size not exceeding 5MB; the name of the file should be the students KUHS Permanent registration number (ID). The printout of online details, signed by all concerned, as per the Proforma should be submitted to the University. The fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted under any circumstances. Also, the thesis will not be accepted after the stipulated date on any grounds and if received after the last date it will not be considered for evaluation.

Important points to be noted in online payment

1. Payment can be made using internet banking and credit card only.

2.Colleges should not wait for the last minute of the date/time fixed for remittance Because there may have problem of connectivity and consequent failure of online remittance and delay in making payments which may lead to imposition of fine, as the case may be, for which the remitter alone will be responsible
