### Instructions to the Principal / Head of Institution

## **Remittance of Examination Fee:**

- The Principal / Head of the Institution should collect Examination fee from all the candidates and remit the consolidated amount to the University Fund through a single Demand Draft drawn in favour of Finance Officer, 'SBI-KUHS Examination Fee Account No. 31768842875, payable at 'Thrissur'.
- The Principal / Head of the Institution should send a separate statement showing the details of those SC/ST/OEC candidates who are not remitting the examination fee with an undertaking that their examination fee will be claimed by the College from the Department concerned and remit the same to the University before the issue of the Mark list.
- 3. All applications for registration should be accompanied by the prescribed fee.
- 4. Those candidates who have shortage of Attendance and have not obtained minimum marks for Internal Assessment are not eligible for appearing the examination. <u>Partial appearance for eligible subjects will be permitted to those candidates who have shortage of internal assessment marks in one or more subjects, but secured prescribed attendance percentage (80%) in all the subjects. Principal / Head of Institution are solely responsible for any lapses in this regard.</u>
- The Institutions which are not recognised as University Examination Centre for Theory Examinations have to remit to the University, an additional amount of₹. 105/- per candidate per paper for using another Approved Centre
- 6. <u>No other fees should be collected from the candidates for this examination purpose</u>.

# **Dissertation Details**

- <u>The printouts of Attendance Percentage and Dissertation Details should be signed by each</u> <u>candidate against their Register Number</u>. This statement signed by the Guide concerned, Head of the Department and duly countersigned by the Principal / Head of the Institution should reach the University before 5.00 pm on the last date stipulated. <u>A photocopy of the</u> <u>same should be displayed on the College Notice Board</u>.
- Applications after the stipulated date will not be entertained on any grounds.
- <u>All candidates appearing for the examination have to submit a soft copy and hard</u> <u>copy of the dissertation through the Head of Department and Head of the</u> <u>institution as per the schedule furnished below. The candidates failing to submit the</u> <u>dissertation on the prescribed date will not be permitted to appear the</u> <u>Examination.</u>
