In exercise of the powers conferred under Chapter V, Section 42 of the Kerala University of Health Sciences Act, 2010, the Governing Council at its meeting held on 9-3-2018 has made ordinances on the following matters with the recommendations of the Academic Council:

1. Inter college transfer of students affiliated under the University;
2. Transfer of Compulsory Rotating Internship;
3. Eligibility criteria for admission to various courses of study for Degree, Diploma and other academic distinctions.

As per the Section 43(iii) of the Kerala University of Health Sciences Act, 2010, permission has been accorded by the Hon'ble Chancellor to publish these regulations.

**KERALA UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES FIRST ORDINANCES
2017 (Academic)**

In exercise of powers conferred under Chapter V Section 42, of the Kerala University of Health Sciences Act 2010, the Governing Council shall make ordinances. As per section 43(i), the Governing Council may make amend or repeal ordinances connected with the maintenance of academic standards shall be made by the Governing Council with the consent of the Academic Council unless a draft thereof has been considered by the Academic Council.

Chapter I

Preliminary

1. Short title and commencement:

(1) These Ordinances may be called the Kerala University of Health Sciences First Ordinance, 2017 (Academic)

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. Definition and rule of construction

(1) The words and expressions used in the Kerala University of Health Sciences Act, 2010(Act 4 of 2011) and the Kerala University of Health Sciences First Statute and used but not defined in these Ordinances shall have the same meanings respectively assigned to them in the said Act or Statutes.

Chapter II

Inter college transfer of students affiliated under the University

Inter-college transfer shall be permitted only for regular students of affiliated colleges under KUHS.

Inter College transfer for the students studying in the colleges affiliated to other Universities within and outside the state shall not be permissible due to the many reasons including the following mentioned :-

- i. Difference in the eligibility criteria for admission to courses conducted by other Universities.
- ii. Difference in Pass minimum
- iii. Difference in Scheme of examination and distribution of marks
- iv. Difference in Course duration
- v. Difference in syllabus and curriculum

2. Transfer shall be considered only for students who have medical conditions of the self, where it is essential to have a transfer to another institution, subject to the recommendations of Medical Board constituted by the University for the purpose.

3 As per the prevailing Government decision a student from Government college shall be transferred to another Government college.

- 4 As per the prevailing Governing Council decision a student from Aided college shall be transferred to another Aided college.
- 5 As per the prevailing Governing Council decision a Student from one self financing college shall be transferred to another self financing college.
6. No notification will be issued for inter collegiate transfer.
7. Application will be considered only if open vacancy is available at the receiving college. (Open vacancy means vacancy arising consequent to non joining, permanent discontinuance with cancellation of registration)
8. The student shall be examined by a Medical Board specifically constituted by the University for the purpose.
9. Based on the recommendations of the Medical Board and regulations of the respective statutory council, the Vice Chancellor shall grant college transfer.
10. If the number of students found eligible for transfer is more than the available number of open vacancies, transfer of students from one college to another shall be made purely on the basis of merit taking into consideration the rank in the entrance examination. If there is no entrance examination, marks in the qualifying examination/previous year's University Examination whichever is applicable will be taken into account.
11. The student is eligible for transfer only once in a course.
12. Application in prescribed format with details of medical certificate along with no objection certificate issued by the college of study and the college to which transfer is requested, NOC from concerned Apex Bodies / Statutory Councils wherever prescribed shall be forwarded through the Principal to the Registrar with the prescribed fee.
13. Data sheet showing mark and rank of the candidate in the Entrance Examination issued by CEE/ authority concerned or allotment memo, from concerned authorities as the case may be, shall also be submitted along with the application.
14. In the case of applications submitted on extreme compassionate grounds the same shall be considered and decided by a subcommittee of the Governing Council consisting of not less than 3 members of the Governing Council.
