- A 16 years old boy presents to ED complaining of shortness of breath and pain on right side of chest. He informs being beaten by hockey sticks in playground 30 minutes ago. His vitals are: respiratory rate – 28/minute, oxygen saturation – 80% on room air, pulse – 110/min, blood pressure – 90/50 mmHg. His Glasgow coma scale is 15/15 with normal pupils and no deficits.
  - What are the possible chest injuries in this patient
  - How will you detect various chest injuries in the ED
  - How will you relieve him of his pain
  - The patient was intubated by an intern and put on ventilator. However, the boy suddenly collapsed with un-recordable blood pressure. Enumerate the probable causes of his deterioration. (3+7+5+5)

- 2. Enumerate causes of acute breathlessness. Describe in detail the etiopathogenesis, presentations and management of bronchial asthma in elderly. (2+2+2+4)
- 3. Enumerate causes of acute pancreatitis. Describe the methods to assess severity of acute pancreatitis in ED. Describe diagnostic studies in a patient with suspected acute pancreatitis. (2+4+4)
- 4. Classify cerebrovascular accident in an elderly patient. Add note on indication, precautions and complications of thrombolytic therapy in a stroke patient.
- 5. Describe in detail about epistaxis and its management in ED
- 6. Classify hypertensive disorders of pregnancy and describe management of eclampsia.
- Classify supracondylar fractures of humerus. Explain clinical presentation of supracondylar fracture. What are the early and late complications of supracondylar fracture. (3+3+4)
- 8. Enumerate emergencies in the first 20 weeks of pregnancy. Management of a patient with ectopic pregnancy. (4+6)
- 9. Describe pathophysiology and microbiology of otitis media. Describe about complications of otitis media. (6+4)
