- A 20 years old 30 week pregnant woman has presented with fever, decreasing urine output, shortness of breath and altered sensorium of one week duration. On examination she was conscious but disoriented, had 40°C temperature, tachycardia, tachypnea, moderate pallor, oedema, raised JVP, mild icterus, crepitations over both bases and audible foetal heart sound. Investigations reveal, haemoglobin of 8.5 gm/dl, TLC-18,000/mm3 with 78% polymorphs, Platelet count 88,000/mm3, blood urea- 156mg/dl, serum creatinine- 5.6 mg/dl, Serum bilirubin- 3mg/dl, SGOT- 345, SGPT- 432, serum sodium- 130meq, serum potassium- 5.2meq. She had plasmodium vivax- positive in peripheral smear. Answer the following:
  - Discuss the clinical situation with differential diagnosis.
  - What additional investigations are required in short term and medium term.
  - What would be the management strategy for various possibilities
